- All grant monies must be used within the confines of the school curriculum.
- No professional training will be accepted.

The need for the grant will be based on the following criteria:

- It will enhance the students' academic development and interest.
- It includes multi-levels of learning and learning techniques.
- It must show a relationship of the requested resources to the curriculum and students.
- It includes cross-curriculum involvement.
- It must involve the parents or other community resources.
